UC Davis – ASUCD Unitrans Facility Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines carefully. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in immediate removal from the facility & revocation of future parking privileges at the facility.

Availability: Depending on space availability and number of requests, charter buses may park at the UC Davis – ASUCD Unitrans facility fee-free on Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. All vehicles must depart by 5:00 PM. Unitrans has no weekend or holiday parking availability. For weekday availability during regular weekday business hours at the Unitrans facility, please call 530-752-4560 or email unitrans@ucdavis.edu with the subject "Bus Parking" to confirm that space is available.

For parking availability on weekdays before 8:00 AM or after 5:00 PM, on weekends, and on holidays, contact the UC Davis Department of Transportation Services by emailing parking@ucdavis.edu or call 530-752-7657 Monday-Friday from 8:30 AM-4:00 PM in advance. Please note that there may be costs associated with parking on campus outside of the Unitrans facility.

Guidelines: All guest vehicles are expected to follow the guidelines below. Please review carefully. See following pages for maps and diagrams.

- 1. The speed limit at the Unitrans facility is 5 MPH. No exceptions. The Unitrans facility is an active bus yard with training and maintenance activities occurring all day.
- 2. All buses and large vehicles must follow directional signage and travel in a counter-clockwise manner. No exceptions.
- 3. Drivers are instructed to check in with our Dispatch office upon arrival and confirm where to park. Vehicles may only park in the main bus parking area near the entry/exit gates. The Dispatch office is located through the two double doors at the front of the building. A restroom and vending machines are available for use. If Unitrans cannot identify a vehicle parked at our facility, UC Davis Police Department and a towing company will be immediately contacted.
- 4. Do not park in any parking spaces that are coned off. These spots are typically at the northern end of the facility near the historic London Double Decker buses.
- 5. Unitrans does not offer fueling or maintenance services. Do not block the fueling island maintenance bays, or travel lanes.

If you do not compile with these guidelines, you will be asked to immediately depart the facility. Failure to comply will result in an immediate call to the UC Davis Police

Department and a towing company. If you violate these guidelines, you will not be allowed to park at the facility again.
